<b>Breadth &amp; Depth of Impact</b>	Success defined as service outcomes; Outputs are short term, direct deliverables provided to finite population.  (i.e. # canned goods collected for food pantry and distributed to 20 families.)	Outcomes have mid-term impact that expands beyond direct beneficiaries to have community-level reach.	Success defined as capacity-building; Outcomes have long term ripple effects and impact expands regionally or beyond.  (i.e. improved distribution system developed to increase food pantry efficacy to serve SEO by 20% henceforth.)
<b>Complexity &amp; Integration</b>	Goals are palliative, with a single-issue focus and do not engage causal factors.	Goals somewhat engage systems thinking, but remain limited in focus.	Goals embedded in systems-thinking and work is intersectional in nature.

<b>Community Participation / Decision-Making</b>	Partners operate autonomously, but keep each other informed.
