

- + Executive MPA is cohort based, where you will develop relationships and professional connections with your classmates over the two-year period.
- + Face-to-face class meetings are held during residencies one Saturday a month, ten times a year, at Ohio University's Dublin Center, 6805 Bobcat Way Dublin, Ohio 43016. These classes bring all cohort members and faculty together in one location for collaboration.
- + Guest speakers from the public sector are occasionally invited to join for lunch/dinner over the course of the program.


